This popular course turns the innovative Orff approach towards the repertoire of jazz. Orff teachers new to jazz will experience the essential elements that allow the beginner to feel successful while jazz musicians new to Orff Schulwerk will learn how to present what they know in engaging and child-friendly ways. Those who have previously taken the jazz course are welcome to attend and refresh themselves while learning new repertoire and games. The course features:

- A developmental sequence for children between 3 and 14 years old.
- Games, songs, speech pieces, body percussion and movement activities.
- Roots music, jazz blues, jazz standards and jazz compositions arranged for Orff instruments.
- Models of integrating other instruments into the Orff ensemble.
- Piano skills to accompany the Orff ensemble.
- Specific guidelines for improvisation.
- Essential jazz theory and key historical, cultural and aesthetic background.

Doug Goodkin, recently completed his 37th year as the music specialist at The San Francisco School in California. He is internationally recognized as an Orff Schulwerk specialist, offering courses in over 39 countries and six continents. He also directs the prestigious San Francisco Orff Certification Course and is often a guest teacher at The Orff Insitut in Salzburg. Doug is the author of eight books, including his ground-breaking and highly acclaimed work on jazz education, *Now's the Time: Teaching Jazz to All Ages*.
